**SPECIAL RUNS**


After 3 normal runs, a special destination is chosen as follows: roll the die once:

1- connections for S ENGLAND: London, Bristol or any half-hex on the bottom edge from C34 to K74

2- connections for EAST ANGLIA: London or any hex from N56 to N71

3 or 4- connections for the NORTH: York, Preston or any half-hex from C1 to M41

5- connections for WALES: any hex from A12 to Newport

6- any seaport: marked by an anchor
